Washington-Wilkes County Airport



Visit Washington-Wilkes County Airport (IYY) and enjoy small town, southern hospitality. Take a step back in time at the terminal building, one of the oldest historical buildings in the world. Airport facilities include radio-controlled lighting with PAPI, NDB approach, and AWOS-3; rental tie-downs and T-hangars with electric bi-fold doors; and 24-hour self-serve 100 LL and Jet A Fuel.

With approved grants, runway width expansion and the addition of parallel taxiways, improvements are scheduled for 2004. Transit services are available Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Please call in advance for rental car information.

The airport's annual fly-in scheduled for October 9, 2004, coincides with the local annual Mule Day festival held at Callaway Plantation.
